**Bulgarian** - zdravei, zdraveite (to many), zdrasti (informal), Dobar den (day);

**Congo** – mambo;

**Czech** - dobrý den (formal), dobrý večer (evening), ahoj (informal);

**Danish** - hej (informal; pronounced hey), god dag (formal);

**Dutch** - hoi (very informal), hallo (informal), goedendag (formal);

**Esperanto** - saluton (formal), sal (informal);

**Egyptian Arabic** - Salaam Alekum;

**French** - salut (informal; silent 't'), bonjour (formal);

**German** - hallo (informal), Guten Tag (formal);

**Greek** - γεια σου ('yah-soo', informal); καλημέρα ('kalimeera', formal);

**Hawaiian** - aloha (pronounced ah-low-ha);

**Hebrew** - shalom (means "hello", "goodbye" and "peace");

**Hungarian** - jó napot ('yoh naput'; formal);

**Italian** - ciao (informal; also means "goodbye"), buon giorno (formal);

**Japanese** - 今日は konnichi wa ('kong-nee-chee-wa');

**Norwegian** - hei ("hi"), hallo ("hello"), god dag ("good day");

**Slovak** - dobrý deň (formal), ahoj (pronounced ahoy);

**Slovenian** — živjo (informal), dober dan (formal);

**South African English** - hoezit ('howzit'; informal);

**Spanish** - hola (pronounced o-la); buenos días formal);

**Swedish** - hej (informal; pronounced hey), god dag (formal);

**Turkish** - merhaba selam (formal), selam (Informal);

**Zulu** - sawubona (for one person),

sanibonani (for many people), meaning 'We see you';
